Zoellner). Research will be focused on a recently discovered process of cytoplasmic exchange between cells, with a view to understanding the cellular and molecular mechanisms responsible, as well as any phenotypic and epigenetic effects. Teaching will be in aspects of basic and systemic pathology. The appointee will receive guidance and mentorship from Prof Zoellner in both research and teaching, but is expected to demonstrate capacity for work independent of close supervision. Applicants will be expected to have demonstrated productive laboratory experience in cell and molecular biology. Further experience in cell and tissue imaging and protein chemistry would be an advantage.
