Major responsibilities include pre-clinical, clinical and didactic teaching, supporting resident and student research projects, competency assessment of pre-doctoral students, provision and monitoring of patient care, and participation in scholarly activities. This position may serve as the Undergraduate Endodontics Clinic Director. The successful candidate is expected to be involved in the School of Dentistry meetings, committees, continuing education, and outreach along with other tasks assigned by the Division Director. Salary and academic rank are commensurate with experience and credentials.

- American Board of Endodontics eligible or certification required.
