This position will work closely with the Chair of Orthodontics in the management of the post-graduate program in Orthodontics and build collaborative relationships with local, State, and national groups that have interest in orthodontics and oral health. Additionally, the candidate will continue to grow the already active clinical services at the School of Dentistry and WVU Hospitals. The candidate should have a proven record of clinical excellence, strong communication skills, team building and a willingness to foster faculty and staff development through continuing education. Prior academic and/or private practice experience is desirable. An MS degree in addition to a specialty certificate in Orthodontics is desirable.

Candidates must have a DDS/DMD degree from an accredited US or Canadian Dental School or a foreign equivalent and be board certified by the American Board of Orthodontics. Candidates must be eligible for a West Virginia dental license and have obtained their WV license by their start of employment, unless special consideration has been approved.
