Responsibilities:

Responsibilities include didactic and clinical teaching pre-doctoral students in the areas of evidenced based patient care, practice management and running highly productive practices. This position may lead to assignment as a Practice Group Leader or assignment as a course director. Faculty members

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are expected to teach in an integrated curriculum system that includes baccalaureate, graduate, and post-graduate education. Teaching across traditional departmental lines and in multidisciplinary teams is required. Faculty members are expected to foster transformative learning that is informed by interdisciplinary and translational research, scholarship, and creative expression.
