Responsibilities and Duties

- Directs all aspects of the Caries Risk Management (CAMBRA) Program: workshops and clinical Caries Risk Management (CAMBRA) Competency Exams, including tracking student's progress.
- Supervise all telehealth activities pertaining to Caries Risk Management (CAMBRA) of 3rd and 4th year dental students in the DMD and IS undergrad programs
- Assist students with preventive treatment planning, and case management of at-risk patients.
- Oversee the Recall Program of the Comprehensive Care Clinics

Teaching

- Teach Caries Risk Management (CAMBRA) across the 4 years of the dental curriculum
- Conduct on-line small group workshops for second year students

Other
