teaching, the candidate is expected to develop and teach undergraduate and graduate level courses in for MS, PhD as well as residents. The candidate is expected to have a history of mentorship of graduate students, postdoctoral fellows, and dental residents.

Eligible candidates are required to possess research expertise and doctoral degree (PhD) in one of the following research areas: biomaterials, materials sciences. engineering, microbiology, molecular biology, or equivalent. The candidate is expected to possess good postdoctoral training with an outstanding publication record. The candidate is expected to demonstrate a high likelihood for extramural funding. Preference will be given to dual trained clinician-scientists (i.e., holding a DDS, DMD, or equivalent degree, and a PhD degree) with a proven track record of funding or with existing extramural support for research.
